Whitney Debevoise currently serves as the United States Executive Director to the World Bank Group where he sits on the Boards of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, the International Development Association, the International Finance Corporation and the Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency.



Mr. Debevoise joined the World Bank from Arnold & Porter, LLP, where he practiced international law for more than twenty-five years.
