Keith Webber is Deputy Director of the Office of Pharmaceutical Science in the Center for Drug Evaluation and Research at the FDA.

He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemistry from the University of Denver and a Doctorate in Biological Chemistry from the University of Michigan.

He joined the FDA's Center for Biologics Evaluation and Research in 1995 and has served in a variety of capacities during his years at the Agency including Director of the Division of Monoclonal Antibodies and Acting Director of the Office of Biotechnology Products. He has been very active in developing regulatory policy on biotechnology pharmaceutical products across the Agency as well as between Federal Agencies. Currently, he serves on the FDA's Council for Pharmaceutical Quality, the Manufacturing Sciences Working Group, the Standards Working Group, the Process Analytical Technology Steering Committee, the Interagency Task Force on Pharmaceuticals in the Environment. He also chairs the Biotechnology Advisory Board at the University of Maryland Baltimore County.
