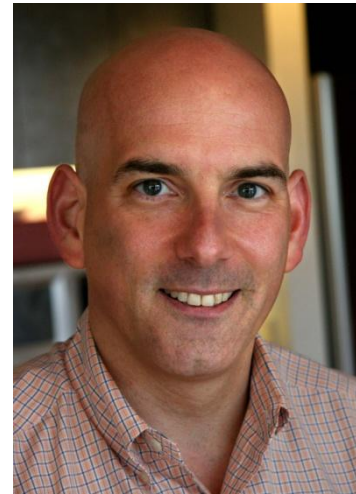


Brian A. Meltzer
