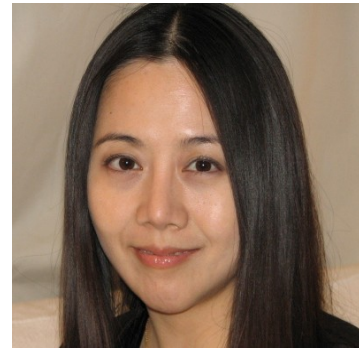


Julia Dan T'05

Julia is currently serving as a Co-Founder, President & CEO of NuCure Bioscience, a biotech startup in the stealth-mode stage, which bridges clinical and commercial therapeutic development globally to meet unsolved medical needs.
