**Byrne Dining has introduced more sustainable, entirely biodegradable, to-go coffee cups.** The previous cups were made of paperboard coated with a low-density petroleum-based polyethylene to prevent leaking. The new cups, called the ecotainer™, use PLA, or poly-lactic acid, a polymer derived entirely from natural cornstarches and is 100% renewable on an annual basis.
