**Directions to Tuck from Hanover Inn**

Walking out of the Hanover Inn’s main entrance, turn left. At the traffic light, turn right. Walk alongside/past the green. Continue through the intersection (Parkhurst Hall will be on your left). Baker Library will be on your right—turn left at the Baker Library main entrance steps onto Tuck Mall Street. Walk to the end of the street, at the circle, Tuck will be on your right, Byrne Hall will be to the left of Tuck (down a small ramp-nestled at the far end of the circle), and Murdough Center (glass and brick building) will be to the left of Byrne Hall. Walking time: 10 minutes

**Directions to Quechee Inn from Hanover Inn (Main Street, Quechee, VT 05059, 1.800.235.3133)**

Exit Hanover Inn parking garage and turn left onto Wheelock Street, travel through the traffic light and down a hill, cross over the river (you are now in Vermont). Take 91 South to 89 North (approximately 5 miles). Travel Interstate 89 (approximately 4 miles) to Exit #1 (Quechee). Turn left at the bottom of the exit and follow Route 4 west toward Quechee/Woodstock. Turn right on Quechee Main Street (landmark: Fat Cat Hat Factory will be on your right). Continue on Quechee Main Street for about one mile (do not branch to the right). The Quechee Inn will be up on a small hill on your right. Driving time: 15 minutes

**Directions to Hanover Country Club from Hanover Inn**

Exit Hanover Inn parking garage and turn right, turn left immediately and travel around the green. Turn right at the stop sign (Parkhurst Hall will be directly in front of you). Continue straight past the Tuck Mall sign on your left, travel several city blocks to a stop sign. At the stop sign Main Street turns into Rope Ferry Road, continue straight. The Hanover Country Club is at the end of the street. Driving time: 5 minutes
